THIS COURT ORDERS that

1. The Applicant be at liberty to serve the Respondents, in accordance with Rule 12(1) of the Rules of Court, with the order of this Honourable Court entered May 15, 2009, attached as Schedule "A" (the "Court Order"), by:



- (b) delivery of a copy of the Court Order and this Order to 1376 Glenbrook Street, Coquitlam, British Columbia, being the residence of John Strohmaier, President of the Ambulance Paramedics of British Columbia CUPE Local 873, by putting an envelope with these Orders in the mail-slot; and
- (c) email a copy of the Court Order and this Order to members of the Respondent through the Applicant's "BCAS-All" email distribution system.

Once delivery of the Court Order and this Order has been made to the Union's Offices and the residence of John Strohmaier, the Respondent Union shall communicate these Orders forthwith to its officers, ^{and} ~~members, servants, agents, representatives, shop stewards, picket captains and any other persons acting or purporting to act on its behalf,~~ by:


- the Court Order and this order*
