Re: Acting Supervisor Selection Process

As part of the 2022 Negotiations the parties negotiated Appendix # 20, Frontline Supervision Working Group. One of the tasks was to create a new Acting Unit Chief Selection process.

After lengthy discussions the parties reached impasse on five issues, and I subsequently wrote arbitrator Vince Ready to assist the parties in resolving the outstanding matters. On October 17, 2023, the parties met with Arbitrator Ready and signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with HEABC regarding the Acting Supervisor Selection Process.

As per the new agreement, vacant acting supervisor positions will be filled in the following process:

- 1. The employer will post the vacant position in accordance with Article 13.03, with the posting only available to eligible members.
 - a. On-Car UC Acting Supervisor members attached to the station in which the vacancy occurs are eligible to apply.
 - b. OCUC Acting Supervisor members attached to the post and platoon in which the vacancy occurs are eligible to apply.
 - c. CEMD, DS, CEMCT Acting Supervisor members attached to the dispatch centre and team in which the vacancy occurs are eligible to apply.
- 2. Successful applicants will be selected in accordance with Articles 13.03(a), (b), (c) and (f). Members can also use their scores for any subsequent applications for equivalent positions for a short period of time.
- 3. Articles (d) and (e) will not apply to these positions.
- 4. Any members who no longer wish to be designated as Acting Supervisors will need to requalify per the new selection process for any subsequent postings they wish to apply for.
- 5. Members may only hold one Acting Supervisor designation at any given time.

Irregularly Scheduled Supervisory Positions:

- 1. Members in irregularly scheduled supervisory positions will be employed to provide backfill of off-car supervisory positions in metro and urban posts, as per the collective agreement.
- 2. These positions will be selected in accordance with Article 13.03.
